DESIGNATION ORDER FOR THE NORTH PENNINES AREA OF OUTSTANDING NATURAL BEAUTY
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Countryside Commission proposed to make and submit to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation the above-mentioned Order.
The effect of the proposed Order, which will not come into operation until confirmed by the Secretary of State for the Environment, will be to constitute the land to which the proposed Order relates, the North Pennines Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, for the purposes of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949.
The area will extend from the South Tyne Valley in the north to the Yorkshire Dales National Park in the south, and from the foot of the Pennine escarpment in the west to Barnard Castle and Wolsingham in the east.
Copies of the proposed Order and of the map referred to therein have been deposited for public inspection at County Halls in Kendal, Newcastle upon Tyne and Durham respectively and at the Civic Centre, Carlisle; Town Hall, Penrith; Town Hall, Alston; Moot Hall, Appleby; Council Offices, Market Square, Kirkby Stephen; Prospect House, Hexham; Council Offices, Fairfield, Stanhope; Civic Centre, Consett; and Council Offices 43 Galgate, Barnard Castle. Copies may also be inspected at the office of the Countryside Commission, Warwick House, Grantham Road, Newcastle upon Tyne.
Any representations with reference to the proposed Order should be sent in writing to the Regional Office, Countryside Commission, Warwick House, Grantham Road, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE2 1QF, so as to arrive not later than 1st December, 1978, and any such representation should state the grounds on which it is made.
